

Synopsis: The story is about the children's Nana's garden and all the work she does. It includes planting, growing and eating vegetables from the garden and all the things you need to know about bugs, soil, etc.

Suggested Activities:

- Discussion: What Maori words do you know? What new ones can we learn together?
- Create: Make flash cards with the new Maori words you are learning and draw pictures.
- Food Prep: Make a salad for a shared meal.
- Planting: Get recycled plastic pots, seeds and soil for the children to plant vegetables. Label what the vegetable is in both English and Maori.
- If the Meeting has outdoor space the children could plant their own garden.

- Pots, seeds/seedlings, masking tape and permanent markers
