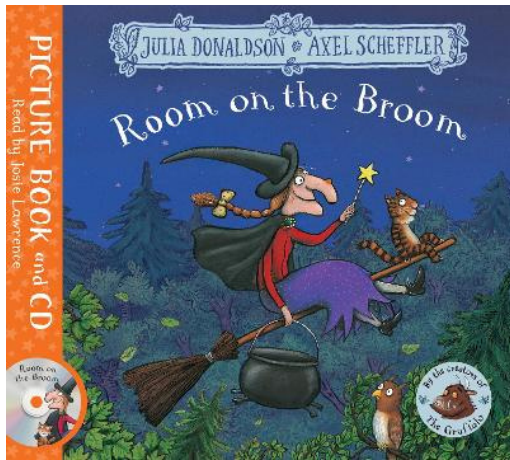


## Testimonies: Community

Synopsis: A friendly witch takes friends on a broom ride and they meet up with what appears to be a scary dragon.

### Suggested Activities:

- As you read this rhyming story, ask the children to say the word that rhymes with the previous sentences.
- Have the children create their own endings before you read the end of the story. A good place to pause reading is after the dragon first appears “I’ll have a witch without chips.”
- Make a broom bookmark. You can use yarn, ribbon thread or straw to make the broom bristles.
- Talk to the children about who they would invite on their broom and why.
- Group Activity. Have a witch hat or cape drawn or real one and have fun and colourful things for the children to glue onto the prop. Hang in Meeting House

### Supplies:

- Bookmark template. Markers, crayons, colour pencils. Glue
- Cape or hat made of paper or fabric and scraps of ribbon, fabric, sequins, etc. Glue
